RULES

of cleaning in the rooms

Charles University, Dormitories and Refectories – Dormitories in Pilsen

The student understands that he/she uses his/her room for temporary accommodation, and so he/she is obliged to keep the reserved area clean, and perform the regular cleaning in the extent as stated below.

Daily:

Take out the garbage into the appropriate bins or containers, sort the waste according to type

Air the room and the bedclothes

In the cells

Perform basic cleaning of the bathroom and the WC, keep it clean after every use

Weekly

Clean the floor, and vacuum clean if there's a carpet in the room

Dust the furniture, shelves and window sill

Wash the sink and shower in the cell, disinfect the WC including the toilet seat

Monthly

Once or twice a month: change bedclothes and vacuum the mattress

Defrost the fridge and wash it well from the inside and outside

Before moving out of the room, the client must clean and clear out the room, and hand it over to an as authorized representative of the dormitory management.

The client also understands that he/she must buy cleaning products on his/her own, at his/her own costs.
