Some basic rules of living here:

1. All buildings have stairs. If you live on floors 1 to 4 use them instead of the elevator, especially to go down. The elevator is slow, there aren't enough of them and a lot of people need it. Please, be considerate.
2. Respect the elevator etiquette. Call only 1 elevator and only in the direction of your ride (e.g. only press the top arrow to go up). Press only 1 floor button. If someone is already getting off at 6th floor, don't press 7th or 5th please – take the stairs instead!
3. If you wish to go to Menza (canteen), go to 0 floor and use the stairs. For gym etc. too!
4. Payment at Mensa is easiest with ISIC. Cash can be paid in the ISIC card at the reception A anytime, but in Mensa you can also use your credit card - ask the cashier.
5. Loud noise between 22 and 6 o'clock is forbidden by law. For a party, rent out a dormitory Party room (Big Clubroom = "Velká klubovna"). Reservations are possible at least 2 days in advance via an email to the DC/dormitory manager.
6. If you wish to explore the famous Prague city nightlife, don't forget to check night connections! Metro (underground) only goes until midnight.
7. Smoking is possible ONLY OUTSIDE! Weed is forbidden by law.
8. Keep the room clean. It is your responsibility.
9. Exchange your dirty bed sheets in a laundry room (follow arrows in tunnels) on Tuesdays (7,30-11 and 13-15 o'clock) and Thursdays (8-11, 13-15).
10. Borrowing keys to the piano, table tennis, aerobic room, oven's room ("Troubárna") etc. is possible at the receptions for free using your dorm ID card. You can also get our dorm gym membership card at the accommodation office for a small fee.
11. Please return the washing machines, drying rooms and vacuum cleaners ASAP. If you are not sure how to use it, ask for directions – better to be safe than sorry.
12. If anything doesn't work in your room (e.g. a lightbulb is broken), use the QR codes on your room entrance doors to get it fixed. For emergencies you can also ask receptionists for their help.
13. And most importantly, please, respect the dormitory equipment and others!!!
