#### A Your Room & The Dorm

- Your new room comes with a bed, desk, chair, wardrobe, blanket, and pillow.
- **Bathrooms:** Your bathroom setup (private or shared on the floor) depends on the assigned building and room type.
- **Bed Linens:** Provided by the dorm, so no need to bring your own. Fresh sets can be picked up in the linen exchange room in **Building I** (follow the arrows on the walls or ask at the reception). Opening hours are posted on the door and in your building's basement: usually Wednesdays, 8–11 AM and 1–3 PM
- **Kitchens:** Each floor has a small kitchen with an electric hob. For a microwave and an electric kettle, just pop down to the area next to the reception. Please note: There is no cafeteria at the dormitory.
- Laundry & Cleaning: You can borrow a washing machine, dryer, vacuum, or iron from the reception for a small fee (around 50 CZK per use). Please bring exact change (coins) the price list is posted on the reception desk glass. And be a good neighbour and return everything quickly when you're done!

### Life in Hostivař: Authentic & Affordable

Let's be real: Hostivař is a residential neighborhood, not the historic center. The upside? It's quieter, more affordable, and you'll live like a true Praguer.

- **Nature & Parks:** Right on our doorstep is a beautiful, large park perfect for running, walking, or just chilling out.
- **Shopping:** You'll find grocery stores like Albert and Norma within easy reach. For a bigger shopping trip, the Vivo Hostivař shopping mall is just a short bus or tram ride away.
- Transportation: Getting around from Hostivař is super easy! Just a short walk away, you'll find tram lines 22 and 26, several bus stops, and the Nádraží Hostivař train station. A direct train will take you to Prague's Main Station in about 15 minutes. For unlimited, affordable travel across the whole city (trams, buses, metro, and trains within Prague), get yourself a Lítačka long-term coupon it's your all-access pass to public transport:
